Replacing or complementing your hard phone, CounterPath's Bria softphone allows you to make Voice and Video calls over IP, see when your contacts are available, send Instant Messages and transfer files with ease and efficiency.

Bria 3 is the first CounterPath softphone built based on the latest technologies to create an unsurpassed user experience. Taking advantage of the most current and flexible user interface frameworks currently available – Windows Presentation Foundation (WPF) and .net for Windows and Cocoa for Mac – Bria enables modern User Interface (UI) features and supports rich media and unparalleled customization. Change your interface color, zoom in and out and benefit from improved task flow for call handling – using Bria has never been more enjoyable.



Powerful Enterprise Features

Bria also includes features specifically designed for business and enterprise users. It can be deployed within an enterprise environment either by manual configuration via the softphone Graphical User Interface (GUI) or by using a provisioning server, like CounterPath's Client Configuration Server (CCS).

Built on SIP and open standards, Bria is proven interoperable with many of the industry's standard platforms and devices.

Multiple Account Integration

Bria 3 allows you to pull in and communicate with contacts from different sources and accounts, including local or company directories, Microsoft Outlook, XMPP, XCap or WebDav servers. Users can also merge contacts into a single view with all of their information from these different sources in the same place. Bria also allows users to see a contact's presence status on their various accounts in order to choose the communication method to reach them best.

Enhanced Security

As voice communications have become more vulnerable to the same type of attacks that data has endured over the past two decades, enterprises are constantly trying to ensure that precautions are taken to ensure privacy and security. CounterPath's Bria provides Transport Layer Security (TLS) and Secure RTP (SRTP) protocols for encrypting both SIP messages and RTP (media streams) between your IP PBX or UC platform and Bria softphone. This provides increased protection from data attacks that can include eavesdropping, wiretapping or threats to security and privacy.

Powerful Enterprise Features

Enterprise-grade telephony features include:

- Call display and Message Waiting Indicator (MWI)
- Voicemail integration
- Speakerphone, mute and redial functions
- "Do Not Disturb" setting
- Call history tab with a list of received, missed and dialed calls
- Conference calling for up to six parties
- Call management functions to transfer, forward and hold calls

Instant Messaging and presence features include:

- Send Instant Messages (IM) and share presence status using SIP SIMPLE or XMPP
- See alerts for incoming IM
- Receive or block notification alerts for contacts' status updates
- Invite and chat with multiple people in one IM (Group Chat via XMPP)

Enhanced Features and Functions

- Contact list containing the individual user's contact information with click to call or IM
- Directory containing names from a shared LDAP directory
- Acoustic echo cancellation, automatic gain control and voice activity detection
- Support for DTMF via RFC 2833 and in-band/out-band DTMF
- Codecs include: G.711 u/aLaw, G.729, iLBC, GSM, Speex, Speex FEC, Speex Wideband, DVI4, DVI4 Wideband and L16 PCM Wideband
- Automatic detection and configuration of audio codecs
- Automatic selection of the best codec based on the other party's capability, bandwidth capability and network connections. Bria also has the capability to switch codecs within a call in response to changing network conditions
- Compliance to 3261 SIP standard
- Support for firewall traversal via STUN, TURN or ICE
- IP Quality of Service (QoS) marking
